Digitizing photographs, objects, documents, and memories to preserve and share the experiences of WWII Japanese American internment.

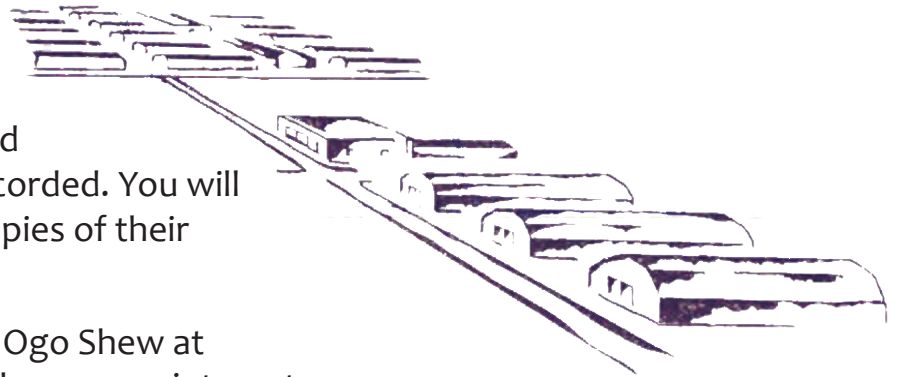
AMACHE DIGITIZATION DAY 4/23/16
